

WEB PRIVACY POLICY

Under Article 13 of the European Regulation 2016/679 (the "**Privacy Regulation**"), **TSL Engineering Srl** intends to make all users and/or visitors of the website <https://www.tslengineering.com/> aware of the use of personal data, log files, and cookies collected through the website.

1. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

The owner of the processing of personal data is **TSL Engineering Srl** (Tax code and VAT no. 05113771009), with a registered office in VIA LIMA, 35 - 00198 ROMA, e-mail amministrazione@tslengineering.com (hereinafter the "Owner").

Information collected by the Site:

a) automatically

- *Browsing data:*

The computer systems and software procedures used to operate this Site acquire, during their normal operation, some personal data whose transmission is implicit in the use of Internet communication protocols.

These data, necessary for the use of web services, are also processed to:

- obtain statistical information on the use of the services,
- check the proper functioning of the services offered.

b) communicated by the user

- *Data communicated by the user:*

The optional, express, and voluntary sending of data, through the different forms on the site, involve the acquisition of the aforementioned information about the sender for requests for services, and management of research, personnel selection, and labor contacts.

c) via cookies

The site uses technical cookies necessary for the use of the Web site.

Under the applicable privacy legislation, **TSL Engineering Srl**, the data controller of the data acquired through the website <https://www.tsengineering.com/> , informs the user that this website does not use profiling cookies to send advertising messages in line with the preferences expressed during navigation.

2. Type of personal data, purposes, legal basis, and retention periods

The processing of data for the above purposes will be carried out by Legislative Decree 30 June 2003 n.196 "Code on the protection of personal data", as well as by the GDPR (EU Regulation 2016/679); reference is made, for what is not specifically regulated by the above-mentioned legislation, to national, European and international sector standards.

2. Compulsory or optional nature of the consent for the provision of data

The provision of data is optional.

3. In what scope can we transmit the data

Data may be disclosed, within the EU, in full compliance with the Privacy Regulation, to the following entities:

(A) the financial administration and/or other public authorities, where required by law or at their request;

(B) to external structures, individuals, and companies that the Data Controller uses to carry out activities related, instrumental or consequential to the execution of the Site Services

4. Security Measures

Through the Site, data are processed in compliance with the applicable law and using appropriate security measures following the legislation in force, also under Articles 5 and 32 of the Privacy Regulations.

5. Rights

Please note that at any time you may exercise your rights under Articles 15 et seq. of the Privacy Regulation, by sending a written communication to the contact details of the Data Controller, to obtain:

- confirmation of the existence or non-existence of personal data with an indication of their origin, verify their accuracy, or request their updating, rectification, and integration;
- access, deletion of data, or limitation of processing;
- the transformation into anonymous form or the blocking of data processed in violation of the law.

One may also object to the processing of personal data previously provided.

6. Changes to the Privacy Policy
